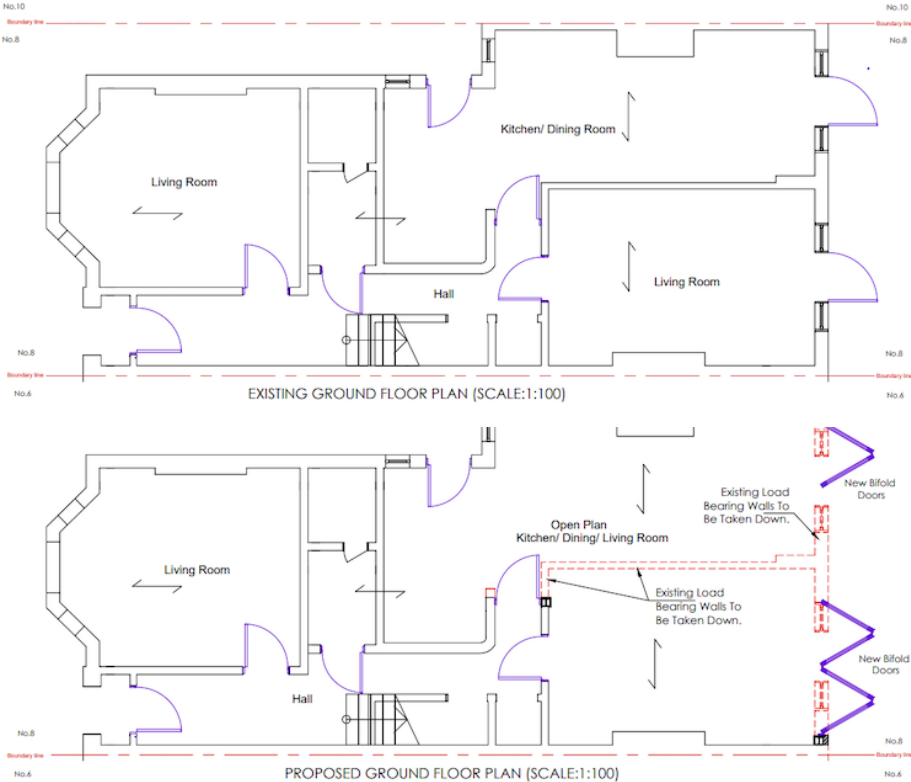
- Full ground-floor renovation with structural alterations to create an open-plan kitchen and living space

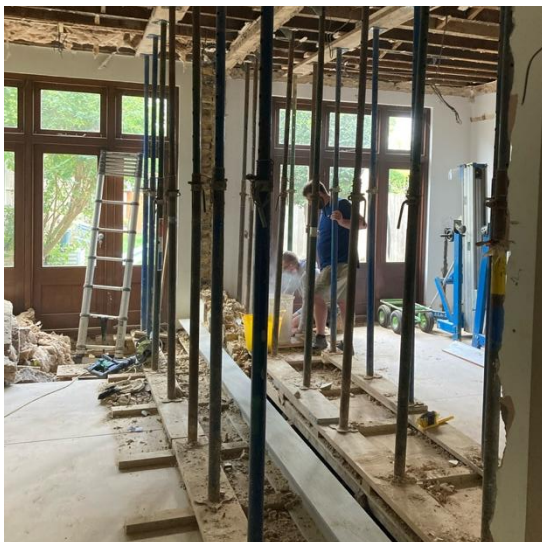


04 Build Process
